St. Monica's **Haiti Medical Mission Effort** provides a physician who offers continuous medical care for the patients of the Whitney Clinic in Haiti five days a week year round. For the first time, medical care is available on a daily basis for our brothers and sisters at Parish Sacre Couer in Hinche. But the Medical Mission Effort is asking for your help to donate the funds necessary to pay this physician's salary, which amounts to nearly \$15,000 per year. **For a donation of only \$60 you can provide the salary of a physician in the Whitney clinic for one full day.** A notification card will be sent upon receipt of your donation. Prior to the opening of clinic on the day of your choice, a prayer will be said by Father Faublas Louis, pastor of Parish Sacre Couer, for the person/family/special intention of your choice.
